NASHVILLE, Tenn. (August 16, 2023) — Critically-acclaimed solo artist **Leigh Nash** and multi-genre singer-songwriter **Jeremy Lister** will co-headline a five-date tour beginning October 1 at Atlanta's Eddie's Attic.

"I've always been a fan of Jeremy's," says Nash. "I'm excited to play some shows together and do some singing on each other's songs too! Can't wait!"

Lister says, "Leigh is one of my favorite humans! I'm so excited to get to share the stage with her this fall. Get ready for a lotta laughs and some tears (the good kind)."

The joint dates follow a solo summer tour for lifelong entertainer Nash, who propelled her first band,

Sixpence None the Richer, to the top of the pop charts with "Kiss Me" and recorded her first platinum-certified album as a teen more than two decades ago.

Last year, she toured throughout much of New England, the Midwest and the Southeast, and made her Grand Ole Opry debut. In October, she launched "[Becoming...](#)," a bi-weekly [YouTube](#) series exploring a multitude of topics with fellow artists, and released [The Tide Acoustic Sessions](#), featuring stripped down versions of her acclaimed [The Tide, Vol. 1](#) album.

In November 2021, Lister released his full-length big band holiday album *Happy Holidays, Everyone*, which has garnered over 4 million streams. The title track landed a spot on T-Mobile's 2020 holiday campaign, and several tracks can be heard on Spotify's Christmas Jazz playlist. In the past year, Lister has had several big music moments on "Grey's Anatomy" Season 19, including his uplifting ballad "One Step," which closed out the mid-season finale.

About Leigh Nash:

For more than a quarter century, Leigh Nash's instantly recognizable voice has been a fixture in modern pop, from her days as frontwoman for Sixpence None The Richer to her more recent output as an Americana solo artist.

Rooted in the southern sounds that previously underscored albums like 2015's *The State I'm In* (her first Top 40 hit on Billboard's country chart), *The Tide, Vol. 1* finds Nash working alongside other mainstays of modern music. Featuring collaborations with country icons like Vince Gill and Tanya Tucker, gospel singer CeCe Winans, and the Grammy-nominated singer/songwriter Ruby Amanfu, the EP features a range of duets that highlight the full span of Nash's artistic interests. The record also earned Leigh Nash her first appearance at the Grand Ole Opry, marking another milestone for a lifelong musician who recorded platinum-certified hits like "Kiss Me" while in her early twenties.

About Jeremy Lister:

Nashville's Jeremy Lister started connecting with music while growing up in the middle of Mississippi. A son of a preacher, he began singing and learning harmonies in church at the age of two. Lister moved to Nashville in 2003, bringing his first EP, *Shooting Star*, with him. In 2005, he released his second EP, *So Far*, followed by the release of his *Just One Day* EP on Warner Bros. Records. That same year, he was invited to join the Ten Out of Tenn collective of singer/songwriters, which included then up-and-coming artists such as Andrew Belle, K.S. Rhoads, and Gabe Dixon.

In 2010, he joined a cappella group Street Corner Symphony for the second season of NBC's "The Sing-Off." The group became a fan favorite, eventually claiming the second-place title in the competition. Ben Folds invited them out on the road immediately following their success on the show, which launched their touring career. Street Corner Symphony performs dozens of headlining shows all over the world each year.

Lister released his first solo full-length album, *The Bed You Made*, in 2011, which featured a duet with Alison Krauss on the song You and I. In 2013, he released the single "Set Us Free," which

became the theme song for the MTV series "The World Of Jenks." In 2017, he and his brothers, together under the name Lister Brothers, co-wrote and released the album *Helium Ocean*.

In the 16+ years since he moved to Nashville, Lister has become a Music City staple, known for his prolific songwriting and unequalled vocal range. He has worked with some of Nashville's biggest names, from Alison Krauss to Amy Grant, Meghan Trainor, and Chely Wright. Since signing with Big Yellow Dog in 2019, Lister has had songs placed with T-Mobile, Dignity Health, the Netflix movie *2 Hearts*, the promo for the season finale of "Modern Family," and more, and has released four EPs: *Sign Language* - 2019, *Cool Cool* (side project with Bergie) - 2020, *Forest for the Trees* - 2020, and *Happy Holidays, Everyone* EP - 2020. His most recent release is the full-length LP version of *Happy Holidays, Everyone*, featuring ten original holiday jazz songs.
